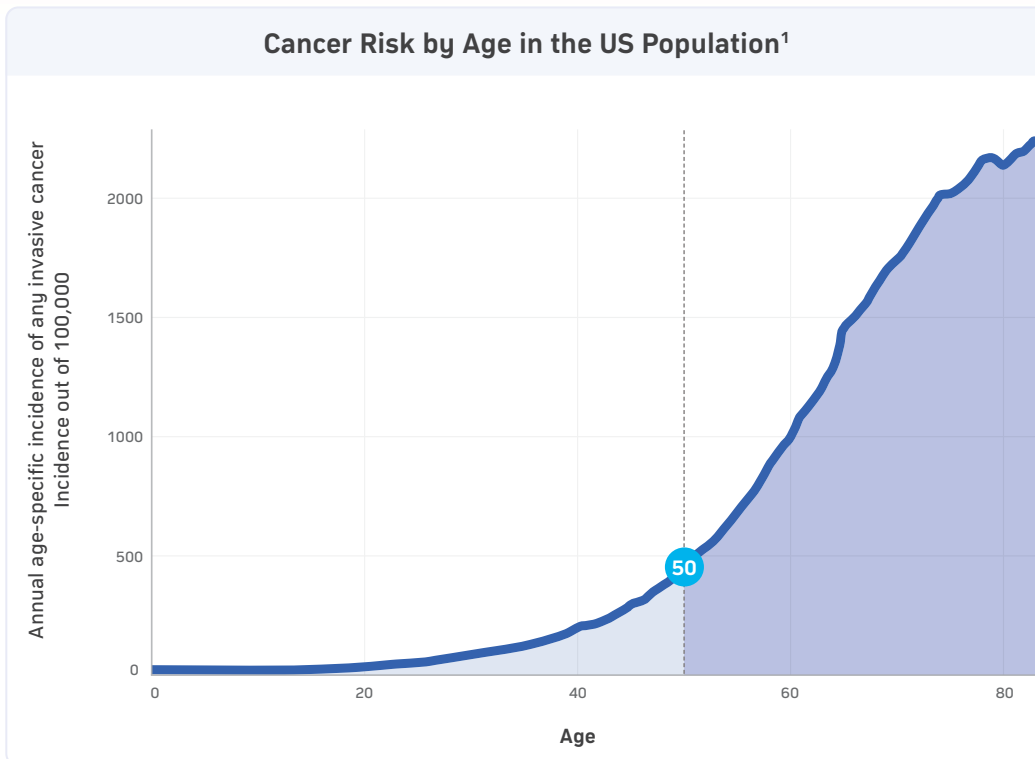


All patients aged 50+ are at an elevated risk of cancer



AGE is the single most important factor for developing cancer*



Patients aged 50 and older are **13X more likely** to develop cancer than those under 50.¹



Only 5% to 10% of all cancers are associated with an inherited mutation.² The majority of cancer cases are from other causes, with the strongest factor being age.*
